Class Schedule: You can check out our class listing in the attached schedule or on our website. If you have any questions about your schedule, just let us know.





SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF TINY TOTS

We are dedicated to providing the highest-quality preschool education in a secure, nurturing, and stimulating environment. Our age-appropriate curriculum and ongoing communication with parents address the physical, emotional, and intellectual needs of our tiniest dancers.

During the first few weeks of classes, we focus on helping students become comfortable with the dance experience, their classroom, teacher, and classmates. Through age-appropriate music, stretching exercises, ballet and tap basics, and creative games, we foster coordination, listening skills, musical awareness, and imagination. Remember, preschool dance is about helping children tap into their imaginations and express themselves creatively, rather than solely learning steps. So don't worry if your child doesn't pirouette around the house right away—it's all part of their dance journey.

The process of separating from parents is an important milestone for preschool children attending dance class. As children grow, they learn to develop an interest in class activities, feel comfortable with their peers, and understand that parents will always come back for them. We understand that some children may initially resist attending class, but it's usually short-lived. Here are some helpful suggestions:

- Focus on the positive aspects of the dance class experience.
- Ensure your child is engaged in an activity or under the teacher's care before you leave.
- Keep goodbyes brief and avoid prolonged farewells.

- Seek assistance from the teacher during the separation process. Remember, any tears shed are often for the parent's benefit.

It's okay if dance class may not be the right fit for your child at this moment. If your child expresses distress or does not want to participate, please don't panic. Pushing children beyond their comfort zones may create negative associations with dance. We never want that. Never force your child into the classroom. If your child discontinues classes within the first month, the registration fee will be credited to the following year's classes, whether that be summer classes or in the 2024-2025 fall season. We encourage you to try again next year, allowing your child to grow at their own pace.



UNDERSTANDING DANCE EDUCATION

As a parent, your support is invaluable to your child's dance journey. Encourage them to be the best version of themselves, focusing on their own accomplishments rather than comparing themselves to others. Dance is an individual art form, and each student progresses at their own pace. Our dedicated faculty not only teaches technique and steps but also imparts essential life lessons. Through dance, children learn commitment, teamwork, and the rewards of hard work. Our goal is to educate their minds, bodies, and souls, providing them with skills that will serve them well in all aspects of life.



Class Placement

Our experienced faculty carefully considers each student's progress and placement. Placement decisions are based on years of teaching expertise and aim to promote self-esteem and confidence. We understand that every child is unique, and factors influencing placement are complex. Trust in our faculty's judgment and encourage your child to embrace their class with enthusiasm. DRESS CODE

At Dynamic Dance Academy, our dress code is designed to foster focus, inclusiveness, and equality among all dancers. By adhering to a uniform dress-wear, we create an environment where teachers can assess technique, alignment, and other crucial aspects of dance training effectively. Let's embrace the dress code with confidence and unity!

To ensure organization, students are required to carry any dancewear, shoes, and belongings in a designated dance bag. Please remember to label your child's bag and all its contents with their name.

During classes, we kindly request that students avoid wearing dangling jewelry, as it can be distracting and a safety hazard. Dance shoes should never be worn outside to preserve their quality and cleanliness.





DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

Ballet

Girls: Leotard or leotard with attached skirt, tights, ballet shoes. A ballet skirt or tutu can be worn over the leotard. Hair pulled back out of the face, either into a ponytail or bun (bun preferred).

Boys: Athletic shorts, tank top or compression t-shirt, ballet shoes. Socks optional.

Jazz & Tap Combo Class

Leotard/leotard with attached skirt or athletic shorts/leggings with t-shirt or tank top. Hair pulled back out of the face in a ponytail. No denim jeans, shorts or school uniforms. Ballet or jazz shoes can be used in class for jazz, and tap shoes must be used for tap.

Нір Нор

Any dancewear or athletic clothing - A t-shirt or tank top with sweatpants, leggings or shorts are all acceptable. No denim jeans, shorts, or school uniforms. Hair pulled back out of the face in a ponytail. If your child has another class before or after, they can leave on the outfit they're wearing for that class. Sneakers must be worn - no sandals, slippers, or Uggs.





REGISTRATION FEE & TUITION

To ensure smooth operations and provide necessary coverage for insurance and administration, we have an annual registration fee. The fee is \$20 for single students or \$35 per family. It's a small investment that helps us create an amazing dance experience for everyone. Please note that registration fees are non-refundable, except for tiny tots who may receive a credit for the following term if they are unready for dance this season.

When it comes to tuition, we want to make it as convenient as possible for you. Monthly tuition is always due in full by the 7th. To offer you a seamless experience, we accept cash, debit/credit cards, check, and Zelle payments. We strive to make financial matters straightforward and transparent, so please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or need assistance.



DISCIPLINE POLICY



At Dynamic Dance Academy, we believe in creating a positive, nurturing, and professional environment for all our students. We emphasize the importance of being part of a group, respecting others, our teachers and staff, and the studio property. Our goal is to foster good habits and cultivate a culture of compliance with rules of conduct.

Our staff and faculty are trained in constructive techniques of discipline to maintain class control and address individual misbehavior effectively. When a child exhibits unacceptable behavior or attitudes, we take a proactive approach. We kindly explain what went wrong and guide them towards a positive alternative approach or behavior.

In the event of a conflict between children, we handle the situation respectfully. They are separated and encouraged to express what happened. We promote problem-solving and communication between them to find a resolution and reconcile with one another.

Disruptive behavior is addressed in a respectful manner. If a child's behavior continues to disrupt the class, we kindly ask them to stop. Should the disruption persist, a reminder will be given, highlighting how it affects others. If necessary, the children involved may be asked to take a short break (typically three to five minutes) before rejoining the class.

If a child's misbehavior persists and continues to significantly disrupt the class, we may need to involve the parent or guardian. We believe in open communication and will reach out to discuss the situation and request the child to be picked up if necessary. Please remember that our ultimate goal is to provide a safe and productive environment for all students.



ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

At Dynamic Dance Academy, we value punctuality and safety for all our students. We kindly ask students to arrive 5 minutes before their class begins, allowing them to settle in and prepare for an amazing dance experience. To ensure the safety of our young dancers, we kindly request that they are picked up no more than 10 minutes after their class ends. Please understand that we are unable to assume responsibility for students before or after their scheduled classes, so it's essential for parents to ensure timely drop-off and pick-up.

We understand that unforeseen circumstances or emergencies may arise, causing delays. If you find yourself in such a situation, please contact the studio immediately. Our priority is to keep your child calm and safe until they can be collected. Your communication is crucial, and we appreciate your cooperation.

ATTENDANCE

Every class at Dynamic Dance Academy is a step forward in the educational journey of our students. Regular attendance is essential for continuous progress and growth. During the season, choreography for the year-end performance will be taught and rehearsed. It's crucial for children to feel completely confident with the choreography and their performance. Missing classes could lead to frustration for the students, their teachers, and their classmates. We encourage all students to prioritize their dance education and make attending classes a top priority.

TARDINESS

Dance is a physical activity that requires a properly warmed-up body to ensure safe movement execution. Students who arrive late miss out on the essential warm-up and/or barre exercises, which may increase the risk of injury. To prioritize the safety and well-being of our students, please ensure you are on time for class. We want all our dancers to enjoy their dance journey while staying safe and injury-free.





CLASS VISITORS

For the safety of our students and to fulfill our legal responsibilities, we are unable to permit visitors in the classroom during regular class sessions. Students should refrain from inviting siblings, relatives, or friends to their classes, except for special events such as "Bring a Friend Week" and in-studio performances. These occasions offer a unique opportunity for sharing the joy of dance with loved ones.

LOST AND FOUND

We know how easy it is for dancewear, shoes, and personal items to get misplaced. To avoid any confusion, please make sure to label all your child's belongings with their name. We will make every effort to locate and return lost items; however, we kindly ask for your understanding that we cannot be held responsible for any items your child brings to class.



The health and well-being of our students and staff are of utmost importance to us. We kindly request your cooperation in keeping our dance community healthy. If any other contagious conditions are observed in your child during a class, we will promptly contact you to arrange for their immediate pick-up. When your child has a fever, please keep them at home until their temperature returns to normal. Furthermore, if there are any lingering signs of illness such as glassy or watery eyes, listlessness, or drowsiness, we kindly request that you keep your child at home. This precaution will ensure that the illness has fully passed, and your child will be well enough to fully participate in class activities the following week.

2. Payment Schedule:

Costume charges are divided into two installments - a \$50.00 deposit per costume due on 10/28, and the balance due on 1/22. Costumes will be distributed only when balances are paid in full. It is the responsibility of parents or guardians to ensure timely payments to avoid any complications. Dynamic Dance Academy is not liable if costumes are not received on time due to late payments.

3. Age-Appropriate and High-Quality:

Rest assured, our costumes are always carefully selected to be age-appropriate and of the highest quality. We prioritize the comfort and aesthetic appeal of our dancers.
